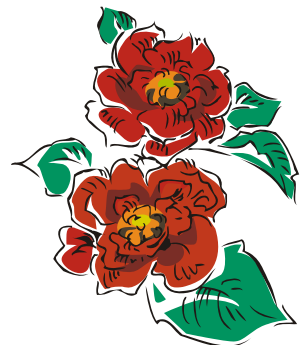

Neil Dempsey and **Dave Meldrum** were fined \$4.99 each for imitating Gene Kelly during the singing of "Singing in the Rain."

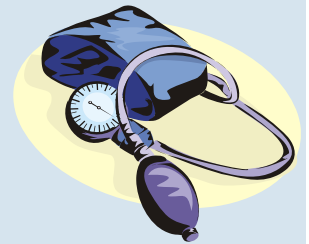
Carl Becker, Ray Glime, Don Green and **Joe Peruzzi** were fined \$2 each for their involvement in the new arboretum in Clinton Township.

Patty McKay paid a \$3 fine for her rare appearance. She is now able to work at home one day a week so we may be seeing more of her.

Terri LeClair introduced today's speaker, Dr. Chris Schnurer, director of Medical Education and director of the mobile Medical Outreach Clinic. The Mount Clemens Regional Medical Center Medical Outreach Clinic provides medical services to residents of Macomb County who are without medical insurance benefits and are unable to pay for their care. Since 1995, the Medical Outreach Clinic has cared for tens of thousands of indigent and "working poor" residents in our community, providing diagnostic, treatment, and preventative medical care at no cost to the patients. In Macomb County, there are approximately 60,000 to 100,000 uninsured people. Approximately 11 percent of these individuals are under the age of 18. Almost 40,000 people are below the federally-designated poverty level and 4,000 people are homeless or migrant workers. The medical clinic consists of a 42-foot, two-exam room customized truck/clinic on wheels. It currently visits four sites in Macomb County. In its 14-year history, more than 36,000 medications have been dispensed to patients. The yearly expense budget is \$275,000. The clinic is staffed by medical assistants, physicians, resident-physicians from the MCRMC Family Medicine residency program, and medical students.
